

Tri-Township Park District

Troy, Illinois
August 28, 1967

The regular meeting of the Board of Commissioners of Tri-Township Park District was held in the City Council Room on Monday Evening, August 28, 1967.

Commissioners present were Russell Wiesemeyer, Milton Langenwaller, and J.W. Dull.

Others present: None.

The meeting was called to order by President Russell Wiesemeyer at 8:00 P.M.

The minutes of the regular meeting of July 24, and the Special Meeting held on August 15 were read and approved as read.

Claims and accounts: A bill from "Photo Copy" of \$5.05 for printing maps and which was paid for by J.W. Dull was read.

It was moved by Milton Langenwaller, and seconded by Russell Wiesemeyer that J.W. Dull be reimbursed for this expense. Motion carried.

Reports of Officers - none.

Reports of Committees: A report for requesting matching fund from the Department of Conservation for the acquisition of Park Property was read by J.W. Dull. It was moved by J.W. Dull, and seconded by Milton Langenwaller, that the report be approved and adopted. Motion carried.

The problems in regards to taking over the park property from Herman Hecht was discussed. It was moved by J.W. Dull that attorney Wendell Durr be requested to send Herman Hecht a registered letter instructing him that he will not be permitted to farm or lease the farm land to plant any further crop after receipt of said letter, and that the out-buildings, excluding the house, shall be vacated for use by the park, by March 1 1968. The motion

was seconded by Milton Langerwalter and carried, as all voted aye.

It was moved by Milton Langerwalter and seconded by J.W. Dull, that President Russell Wiesemeyer be instructed to contact a farmer in regards to planting a fall wheat crop for the Park District. The motion carried, as all voted aye.

No further business appearing, President Wiesemeyer declared the meeting adjourned at 9:30 P.M.
