The June meeting of the Board of Commissioners of the Tri-Township Park District was held at Russ's Car Wash Monday Evening June 24, 1968

Commissioners present were Russell Wisemeyer, Milton Langerwalter, Stuart Gindler, and J. W. Dull.

Others present were: Attorney Wendell Durr.

President Russell Wisemeyer called the meeting to order at 8:30 P.M.

Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved as read.

Claims & Bills: None.

Communications: A copy of a letter which was sent to East-West Gateway, by attorney Durr concerning the assets of Tri-Township Park District was read. A letter from the Illinois Association of Park Districts urging us to write letters to our Congressmen in support of Bill S-1401 was read. This bill provides for appropriations for Park Districts of \$200,000,000.00 nationally and about \$12,000,000.00 for Illinois. A news letter from Ill. Assn. of Park Districts was read concerning a Legislative Seminar at Chicago on August 2nd, 1968, and a regional meeting at Miles on Aug. 3, with forms for registration of members wishing to attend.

Attorney Durr reported that he had already been contacted by bonding firms concerning bonds for swimming pools etc. for our Park District.

It was moved by Dull, and seconded by Gindler that the President and Secretary be empowered to execute Ordinance No. 1968-1, which is the proposed appropriation ordinance for the Fiscal Year 1968-1969 as presented by attorney Durr. The motion carried as all Commissioners voted aye.

It was moved by Dull, seconded by Gindler, and carried that the meeting be adjourned. The President declared the meeting adjourned at 10:30 P.M.
