

August 27, 1973

Members of the board of the Iri Township Park District held their regular meeting Monday, August 27, 1973 at Russ' Car Wash.

The meeting was called to order at 8:05 P.M. with the following Commissioners present - Russ Shusimney, Oscar Gindler, Milton Langenwatter and George Schmalz. Also present at the meeting were J.W. Dull and Lee Leonard.

The minutes of the July 23, 1973 meeting were read and approved as read.

It was moved by Schmalz and seconded by Gindler that bills be paid as presented. Motion carried.

Treasurer's Report was read, Gindler made a motion to approve it, Schmalz seconded it and the motion carried.

Secretary Langenwatter reported that a "thank you" letter had been sent to Hamel Ready-Mix Co & Bergman-Taylor Seeds, Inc. for their respective donations of concrete and weed control.
