

The Township Park District
June 25, 1973

The regular meeting of the Township Park District was held Monday, June 25, 1973 at Russ' Car Wash. Meeting was opened at 8:00 PM. Commissioners present were Russell Wresenmeyer, Melton Langenwatter, Oscar Gindler and George Schmalty. Others present were J.W. Dull and Lee Leonard.

The minutes of the May 28, 1973 meeting were read and approved as read.

It was moved by Oscar Gindler to pay bills as presented, seconded by Russell Wresenmeyer. Motion carried.

Motion was made by George Schmalty to approve the Treasurer's report, seconded by Russell Wresenmeyer. Motion carried.

A motion by Gindler to approve 1973-2 Tax Levy Ordinance was seconded by Schmalty and carried.

It was reported that Russ Wresenmeyer, Oscar Gindler and Geo. Schmalty attended the Ill. Assoc. of Park Districts' Meeting in Granite City, May 30, 1973.

Wresenmeyer reported that 47 picnic tables were assembled by four boys working under the poverty program. They were obtained through Ted Teddesoffer in Edwardsville under the civil defense program. The boys are now starting to work on the shelters and S.B.Q. Grills.

The motion made by Schmalty, seconded by Gindler to order five drinking fountains from Watson Lumber Co also carried.

Oscar Gindler reported that the cat tails in the lake had been sprayed by Alvin Loyt and were to be sprayed one more time.

Russell Wiesemeyer made a motion to insure the house for \$7,000 and the barn for \$1,000 if possible. Leo Schmalz seconded the motion and it carried.

Leo Schmalz made a motion to temporarily close the Northwest exit and lock the other exit leaving only the main gate open and this opening to be at the discretion of the police. Oscar Gindler seconded the motion and it carried.

Motion to adjourn made by Milt Langenwalter at 9:45 P.M. was seconded by Russ Wiesemeyer and carried.
