## MINUTES - TRI-TOWNSHIP PARK DISTRICT

The regular monthly meeting of the Tri-Township Park District Board of Commissioners was convened at the pavillion meeting room at 7:30 P.M. on September 15, 1981 with vice president Milton Langenwalter presiding. In addition to Commissioner Langenwalter Commissioners Foucek and Leonard answered present to the roll call.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved. Following on to the minutes Commissioner Leonard will contact the City of Troy concerning the October 1, 1981 target date for burial of the power lines and Mr. Lanahan on the status of the soccer field construction.

The treasurer's report was read and the bills were presented. Motion to accept the treasurer's report and pay the bills was made by Commissioner Foucek, seconded by Commissioner Leonard and carried.

Motion was made by Commissioner Leonard to transfer \$20,000.00 from Troy Security Bank account #42385 to a money market certificate. The Board agreed to reinvest interest received from the last six months on the Swim Pool Fund back into that account.

Commissioner Leonard noted that the P.T.O. has requested a date for the pavillion for an ice cream social. The only open date is October 10th. Commissioner Leonard will so advise the P.T.O.

The Board received a letter from the Lions Club relative to making the Park the future site of the Troy Homecoming. Motion was made by Commissioner Leonard to set up a meeting with Lions Club Directors at a later date to discuss this request. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Foucek and carried. Commissioner Wiesemeyer will be asked to make the arrangements.

Commissioner Leonard reported that the Park flag was stolen two weeks ago and returned to the police station today.

Due to the fact that mail cannot be delivered inside the Park, Commissioner Leonard has arranged to have two mailboxes set at the entrance for the Sr. Citizen building and the mobile home.

Meeting was adjourned at 9:10 P.M.
