Any furnishings brought by the tenant must be insured by the tenant.

The tenant will be required to pay for telephone, electric and gas services. Minor repairs will be at the expense of the tenant. Major repairs will be at the expense of the District.

The tenant is also required to be alert to any acts of vandalism occuring on park property and report those incidents immediately to the Troy Police Department.
