

The regular monthly meeting of the Tri Township Park District Board of Commissioners was convened at the pavilion meeting room at 7:30 P.M. on October 16, 1984, with president Russell Truempy presiding. Commissioners answering present to the roll call in addition to the president were Arth, Fownd & Leonard. Jasper Pendleton & Daniel Rollberg were also present. The minutes of the previous meeting were read & approved.

The treasurer's report was read & the bills were presented. Motion to accept treasurer's report & pay bills was made by Com Arth, seconded by Com Fownd & carried.

Jasper Pendleton asked the Board to consider him for occupancy of the mobile home in exchange for work in the park. Com Truempy explained that the mobile home should be put on a basis of work exchange for rent or the park will have to pay property tax on it. Daniel Rollberg advised the Board that his wife is expecting a child & he is looking for larger quarters. Pendleton said he

will be ready to move in as soon as Rollberg moves out. Com Wisniewski advised Pendleton that approximately 12 hours work each week would be expected as exchange for rent & utilities would be paid by the occupant.

The partial enclosure of the pavilion was so well received that motion was made by Com Lomax, seconded by Com Arth & carried to complete the job.

Com Leonard read a letter from Evelyn Bowles on disposition of tapes. The Board agreed to turn the letter over to Attorney Cadagin for reply.

No response was received on the ad for applicants to fill the vacancy on the Board created by Com Langewalt's resignation.

Another incident of vehicle damage to park grounds was reported & a person has been apprehended & turned over to the County authorities.

Com Leonard called Watkins about another bid for zinc chromate on the pavilion roof. No response has been received. Com Wisniewski asked

Com Leonard to follow up on it.

Com Beth suggested that the lake be closed for fishing and then restock it with fish. Motion to purchase 300-500 fingerlings ^{through the Bethel fish hatchery} was made by Com Fouch, seconded by Com Leonard & carried.
