AN ORDINANCE MAKING APPROPRIATIONS TO DEFRAY
ALL NECESSARY EXPENSES OF THE TRI-TOWNSHIP PARK DISTRICT

Be It Ordained by the Board of Commissioners of the Tri-Township Park District, Madison County, Illinois:

ARTICLE I
